**GOVERNMENT OF HAITI AND PARTNERS PRESENT LIVE OUTDOOR SCREENINGS OF  
THE WORLD CUP IN PORT-AU-PRINCE**

The Haitian Government, in partnership with the United Nations, is bringing live broadcasts of the World Cup to Haiti for five weeks. On Friday, June 11th, giant LED screens provided by Nocturne Productions through FilmAid International were installed in the national stadium in Port-au-Prince, allowing thousands of Haitians to follow the tournament in real-time through a satellite feed provided by FIFA and the Haitian Government.

This impressive and unprecedented screening event is made possible thanks to the coordination and support of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH) and FilmAid International, and in-kind contributions of a number of additional partners including the Bernard Mevs Foundation, PSI-Haiti, Telemobile, CDAC, Digicel, Win Group and Multilink who ensured internet connectivity for the event.

Throughout the duration of the World Cup, the partner organizations also screen public service announcements, feature films, music videos and entertainment for children along with live concerts featuring Haiti's most prominent artists on a professional performance stage provided by Tait Towers. Additionally, the Haitian Football Federation supported by MINUSTAH is coordinating with local teams to hold informal soccer matches in the stadium and neighboring areas.

Along with shelter, food, and healthcare, Haitians affected by the earthquake also need entertainment and information. Sports, films, music and art transcend politics and can help heal the most damaged communities. The live broadcast of the World Cup in Port-au-Prince brings Haitians together and unites them with the rest of the world.
